January 20	First day for circulating nominating petitions (76 to 56 days to circulate)
February 2	Last Day to Approve Ballot Question for Council
February 4	Last day to certify ballot language
February 9	Deadline for returning nominating petitions 3:00 p.m.
February 12	Last day candidate may amend/correct nomination petition Deadline for candidate to withdraw - Deadline to file Notice of Intent for Write-in Candidate
February 16	Drawing of lots for placement of candidates' names on ballot**
February 19	Last day to submit Pro/Con statements*
February 19	Mail to Overseas Voters
March 5	TABOR notices to be mailed today
February 27	Publish Notice of Election on February 27 th , March 6 th & 20 th and April 3 rd
March 16	First FCPA report due by 3:00 p.m.
March 15	Deadline to cancel election***
March 19	Deadline to mail ballots to all active, registered City electors (window to mail is from March 13 through the 19)
March 22	Walk-in poll opens in City Clerk's office
March 29	Judges begin verifying and ballot counting can <i>technically</i> begin**** Deadline to apply for absentee ballot at 3:00 p.m.
April 2	FCPA report due by 3:00 p.m.
April 6	Election Day – Polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All valid ballots received by 7 p.m. will be counted
April 20	Oath of Office administered at regular meeting of City Council
May 6	Final FCPA report due by 3:00 p.m.
